() C F&GC Yearly Event / Activity / Task Description:**

Downtown Planters – A team of Members design what will be planted and purchases materials for the planters (total 26). Join a watering team which maintains around 3 designated planters one week per month all summer long.

Library Gardens – Join one of six teams which plants, maintains, waters, and weeds the library gardens in summertime and early fall.

Perennial Plant Exchange – It is set on the first Saturday of June in a friendly and casual atmosphere to outreach our local community/residents with free of charge for a two-hour event at a downtown parking lot in Clarkston. Help with collecting contact data from our patrons or distribute Plants labels or Directing pots/plants traffic or give out Garden Walk flyers.

Garden Walk – It is usually set on Wednesday during the second week in July with 6 gardens touring around Clarkston vicinity. Help is being a Garden hostess at one of our 6 gardens with 4-hour shifts.

Wreath Roping and Blanket Sale – Help sell to existing or new customers. Help unload truck and distribute greens to members and customers.
